What is the Interior Lighting Campaign?

The Interior Lighting Campaign (ILC) is a recognition and guidance program designed to help facility owners and managers take advantage of savings opportunities from high efficiency interior lighting solutions, specifically with troffer lighting. The ILC organizers are currently compiling resources including specifications, case studies, and educational webinars to help building owners make sound troffer lighting decisions. Limited technical assistance from the U.S. Department of Energy will be available to site owners and managers who sign up.

Why Troffer Lighting?

Half of all commercial fluorescent lighting fixtures are recessed troffers in 1'x4', 2'x2', and 2'x4' configurations that operate for more than 10 hours a day, and collectively consume over 87 TWh of electricity annually; as much energy as 7 million homes would consume in a year. By adopting the Better Buildings Alliance specification for troffers, building owners can save 15-45% on a one-for-one basis, and up to 75% with the use of controls.
